Youth for Environment Day @ KHS, 07 April 2017

The Youth for the Environment Day (YED) @ KHS is a key annual platform, to engage Kong Hwaians to lead and participate in environmental programmes. The theme for this year's YED is 'Love Your Food'. We would like to encourage Kong Hwaians to carry out simple environmentally-friendly acts such as minimising food wastage, and influence their friends and family to do the same.

On **7 April 2016 (Friday)**, the school will renew our commitment to care for the environment. Ten Green Captains will embark on the 'Love Your Food @ Schools' Experiential Trail' this year, organised by the National Environment Agency (NEA). The activities lined up for the day include:

- Monthly Recycling of old newspapers and papers
 - Kong Hwaians are encouraged to take them to the recycling corner before morning assembly
- Recycling of used storybooks
 - Kong Hwaians will donate their used story books (from 3 Apr to 5 Apr, booth will be set up near the dental clinic)
 - Kong Hwaians will get to select from the pool of used story books collected. They can select not more than the number of books which they have donated earlier. (The Pupil's Handbook should be brought along during donation and selection of the used storybooks, for tracking purposes)
- Food waste generated from recess will be weighed and tabulated per level to raise awareness of food waste minimisation.
- Earth Hour – Fans in classrooms will be turned off for an hour; air conditioning temperature will be maintained at 25 degrees
- Wearing green – Teachers and Kong Hwaians are encouraged to wear green attire to school as a show of commitment to care for the environment. Pupils should come in green t-shirts (no tank top and spaghetti straps), school shorts for boys, school skirt for girls and school white shoes and socks.

We appreciate your support for our efforts in minimising our carbon footprint for the betterment of our children's future.
